

RULES

1. **ALL** jams, jellies, marmalades and chutneys must have been made by the exhibitor since September 2009 and must be displayed in a '1lb' jar with screw top.
2. **ALL** flowers, vegetables and fruit exhibited must be own-grown.
For the 3 flower arrangement classes 27, 28 & 29, flowers etc may be bought.
For all flower classes, exhibitors must provide their own vases/containers.
3. **ALL** exhibited pot plants must be the property of the exhibitor and must have been in his or her possession for at least 3 months before the Show.
4. To achieve more conformity for the judges, all vegetables and fruit, where appropriate, must be displayed on plain white paper plates. *Exhibitors provide own plates.*
5. For the two knitting classes 68 & 69, the items must have been made within the last 3 years.
6. **For all classes, the judges' decisions are final.**

8. **Exhibits must be presented in the church between 9-00 and 10-30am on the day of the Show.**

NO EXHIBITS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS TIME.

They may not be removed until after the presentations.

Any exhibits not collected by the end of the Show will be donated to local charities.
