13. Men's only cake (no help, supervision nor advice!)

**Section B FLOWERS - 17 Classes**

15. 1 single rose
16. 4 stems of roses (any variety)
17. 4 stems of any annuals (may be same type or different)
18. 6 stems of any different flowers (perennials or annuals)
19. 2 sprays of fuchsias
20. 3 cactus dahlias
21. 3 pom-pom dahlias (max. size of flower head 75mm / 3" diam.)
22. 3 flat dahlias
23. 3 chrysanthemums
24. 2 sunflowers (children welcome as well)
25. Foliage plant in pot
26. Pelargonium (geranium) in pot
27. Flower arrangement in an unusual container (36cm/14" max. width)
28. Flower arrangement using 5 flowers (36cm max. width)
29. Foliage arrangement (can use berries and/or seed heads - no flowers -36cm.max width)
30. 1 flowering house plant
31. 1 cactus (any size)

**Section C VEGETABLES & FRUIT - 25 Classes**

32. Oddest shaped vegetable (can be any 'undoctored' vegetable)
33. 4 carrots (trim tops to 75mm / 3ins)
34. 3 parsnips (trim tops to 75mm / 3ins)
35. 4 potatoes (any type)
36. 3 onions (red or white)
37. 5 shallots

38. 3 beetroot (trim tops to 75mm / 3ins)
39. Longest marrow
40. 3 courgettes (same colour)
41. 1 'exotic' vegetable eg gourd, squash, aubergine, pepper

***Important pointers towards judging decisions for vegetables, fruits and flowers:***

*The judges will be looking for good condition, uniformity (for classes for more than one vegetable or fruit), size, shape and colour, in that order of priority.*

*For flowers, they will be looking at the form, freshness, condition of flower(s) and leaves, size, colour, in that order of priority.*

**Classes 57 to 61 - Photographs must be unmounted and not larger than 18cm x 13cm (7"x 5"). NB One photo only may be entered per person per class**

58. Photo of a plant or flower(s)

61. Photo of a scene featuring water (can be sea, lake, pond, river or stream)
62. A watercolour painting of a landscape
63. A painting of a flower or plant (any medium)
64. A drawing of a still life featuring fruit or vegetables
65. An item of embroidery (eg tablecloth, picture)
66. A piece of needlepoint (tapestry) (eg picture, cushion cover, fire-screen)
67. An item using cross-stitch
68. A hand-knitted adult's garment
69. A hand-knitted accessory or article (eg bag, cushion cover)
70. A soft toy (can be knitted or sewn from any fabric)
71. A limerick - first line to be: " A Deddington woman called ....." "

84. A collage made with paper, fabric etc (any subject or pattern - max size A3)
85. A 'junk model' of a train, car, tractor, fire engine or aeroplane, made out of throw-away cans, toilet rolls, packets, plastic containers etc
86. A castle made from one or more cornflakes or similar packet(s)
87. A paper aeroplane
88. A piece of jewellery made by you
89. A creature made out of vegetables
90. Miniature garden on a dinner plate
