

## UPDATE FROM THE PCC MEETING – 19 NOVEMBER 2009

### **Co-option of PCC Member:**

The PCC is very pleased to report that Olivia Fenion has been co-opted to the PCC with effect from 19 November 2009. She replaces Alex Spittal, who we would like to thank for his service to the PCC.

### **Youth Worker:**

The Youth Worker role has been advertised in Youth Work magazine and on their online job page. The closing date for the receipt of applications is Friday 18 December 2009.

### **Deddington Farmers' Market:**

George Fenemore has kindly volunteered to work with the Farmers' as supervisor of church stall holders.

### **Notice Boards:**

Two new external notice boards will be erected in the church yard to advertise village and local events. The PCC has also agreed that the Church services notice board needs refurbishing and updating.

Viviane Hall will continue to monitor the materials being put up on the internal notice boards as it is felt that these should largely reflect church matters. If you are unsure where to place a notice please speak to Viviane in the first instance.

Notices and announcements will now be made prior to the start of the Sunday service and will be given by one of the Church Wardens. If you have any notices to be given out please ensure that either Glynne or George have the relevant information prior to the service.

### **Recording of Services:**

The PCC is looking at making services more accessible for those unable to attend church. This may be achieved by using digital radio or producing CD's of services. David Rogers of Mill Close, Deddington has volunteered his time and expertise to assist in this.

### **Repairs and Maintenance:**

- The PCC has authorised a survey to be undertaken of the trees in the churchyard.
- Quotes have been received and are with the insurers regarding the recent vandalism to the window by AJ Bromsgrove. The PCC have voted in favour of spending money from funds on three grilles to protect the stained/coloured glass windows. A planning application and faculty request are in progress.
