

UPDATE FROM THE PCC - 22ND SEPTEMBER 2010

Stewardship: The issue of Stewardship will be raised at the October Forum.

Warriner Youth Worker: Sue Newby, Jon Cardy's line manager, will be coming to speak to the November PCC meeting.

Grand piano: Discussions continued, including the feedback received from the congregation and Farmers' Market. Further investigations will take place.

Tsogo support: Discussion about the best way for the Church to support Tsogo resulted in a unanimous proposal to support an assistant and review it at the end of a year.

Report from Diocesan Synod: Discussion took place about how we could play a role in building a better neighbourhood and a booklet on this subject, produced by the University of Coventry and others, has been left in church for people to look at. A DVD about creativity will be shown in the background during the Forum.

Updating main notice board outside Church: Slot in sections will be created in due course.

Worship Review Group: A group has been set up.

Volunteers for Youth Group/Pastoral Care: It was acknowledged that the Youth Group and Pastoral Care team could do with further support.

Charges for Church stalls at Farmers' Market: It was agreed that a review should take place of the charges and collections of the donations.

Pews: As previously agreed by the PCC, two pews will return once the repairs have been made.

Hempton Christmas Bazaar: It will take place from 11 a.m. on Saturday 4th December and lunches will be available for sale.

Deddington Bazaar: It will take place on 6th November between 11-2.

Disposal of unwanted items in Church: It was agreed to aim for a deadline of November.

Teas in Church on Sunday: It was agreed that the non-fundraising TICOS could continue.

New Media/Internet Cafe: There has been a certain amount of interest in having an internet cafe in the Church and the sessions will be advertised. It was agreed that David Rogers should speak on these subjects at the Forum.
