As the rules change, we are starting to see our lives have some elements of the pre-Covid normality. Deddington Primary School has reported a very successful return for its F1, Y1 and Y6 pupils with key worker children still in attendance. This week, three temporary outside classrooms (gazebos) have been erected to facilitate outdoor classes. We know the new arrangements have been very difficult to get right and we would like to thank Mr Evans, the Head, and his staff for all they are doing to keep our children safe.

We, the Deddington Parish Response Team, wanted to ask for 3 simple things:

1. **Ask for help if you need it** – we know that we are a long way from 'normal' but if you or anyone you know needs a hand, please just ask. We are here for everyone.

2. **Support local businesses** – as we dropped into lockdown, local business did an incredible job to support the community. Now is the time to support them as we all find new ways of working.

3. **Continue to be kind** – the parish has shown its greatest values during lockdown. Let's celebrate our differences and what unites us. We are stronger as a community.

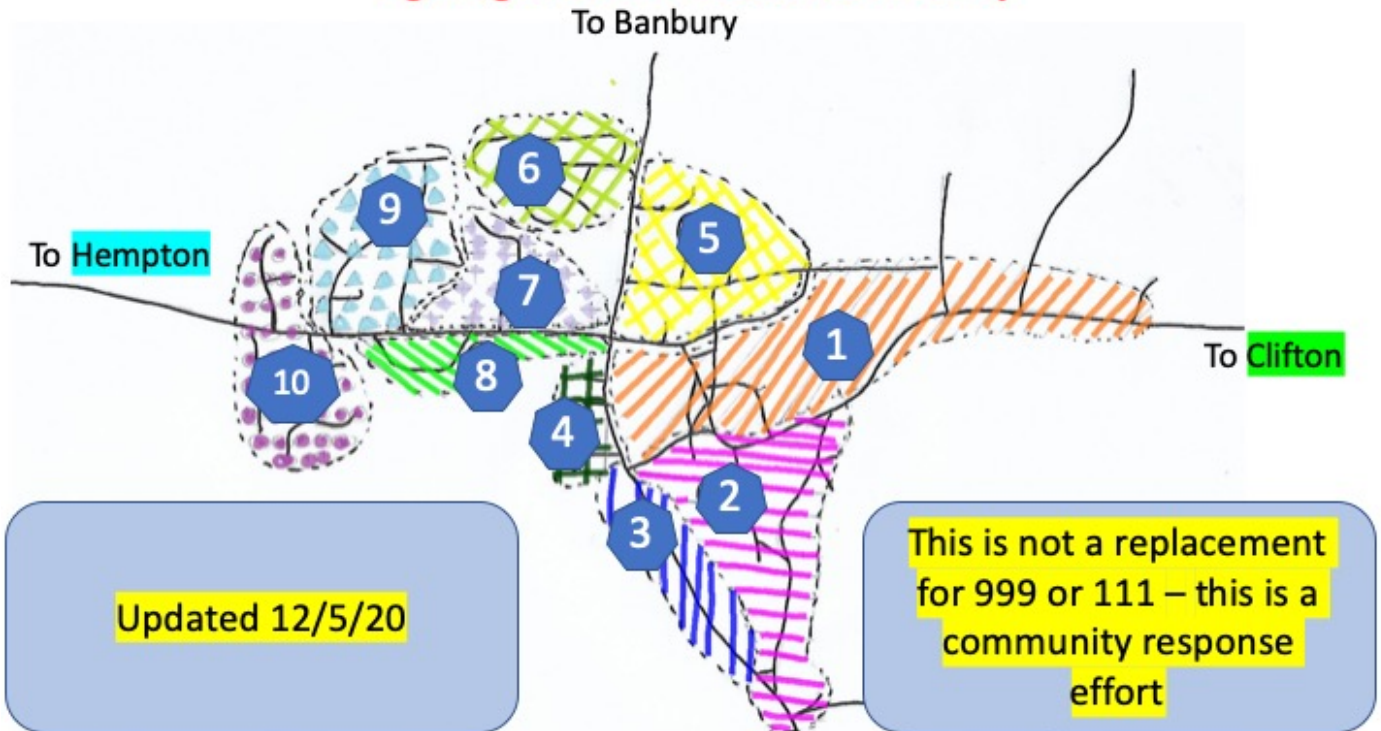
# Deddington COVID-19 Response
