

## **DEDDINGTON DEVELOPMENT WATCH PRIVACY POLICY, 6 August 2018**

The purpose of this privacy policy is to explain how Deddington Development Watch uses your personal information. It has been developed to comply with the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and associated data protection legislation.

### **What we do**

Deddington Development Watch is a committee-led voluntary group comprising individuals who are interested in development activities in and around Deddington. We use a mailing list to alert residents to planning developments in the local area from time to time, as follows:

- information about planning applications; and
- Information about development plans or public consultations by bodies such as Cherwell District Council and the Oxfordshire Growth Board.

### **How we use your information**

In order for you, as a member of our mailing list, to receive updates via email, we collect, store and use the following information about you:

- Name
- Address
- Email address

Deddington Development Watch is the data controller for this information.

We need to process your information to meet our legitimate interests of keeping those who are interested in local planning issues informed of developments and updates.

Your information is stored securely and access is limited to a designated member of the committee.

We will keep your information for as long as you remain a member of our mailing list. If you unsubscribe, we will delete your information.

The Deddington Development Watch website does not support the input of details concerning individuals on its mailing list.

### **Your rights**

Under certain circumstances you have the following rights in relation to the information that we hold about you:

- The right to request access to your data.
- The right to request correction of your data.
- The right to request erasure of your data.
- The right to object to the processing of your data.
- The right to request that the processing of your data is restricted.
- The right to request the transfer of your data to another party.

If you want to exercise any of the rights described above or are unhappy with the way we have used your information, you should [email](#) the Hon. Secretary. We will seek to deal with your request without undue delay, and in any event in accordance with the requirements of the GDPR. Please note that we may keep a record of this to help us resolve any issues which you raise.
