

Viv's Legacy – 'Hope for Ukraine'

Deddington artist Viv O'Donnell's final picture – a beachscape that invokes the flag of Ukraine – painted just seven days before her death on 9 June.

Her wish was to raise money for Ukraine and its people who are suffering due to the war with Russia through the sale of her picture. A posthumous act of compassion to help those less fortunate than herself, clearly demonstrating the caring and loving person that she was.

The picture can be viewed in Deddington Parish Church, along with a notepad on which to record your name, contact details (phone or email) and the amount of your bid. Proceeds from the sale to the highest bidder will go to Deddington charity 'DrivingUkraine'.

Bids are invited up to 4 August, and the successful bidder will be notified by phone or email during August.
