Exhibitors may enter 2 exhibits for each class apart from the Photography Section - <u>one photo per exhibitor for each class.</u>
No exhibitor may be awarded more than one prize in anyone class.

COOKERY SECTION - 18 CLASSES

Section rules: * All jams, jellies, marmalades, and chutneys must have been made by the exhibitor since September 2024. * Each must be displayed in a screw top jar, minimum size of jar 227gms.

The 2025 Parish Show Apple Cake Recipe Age Group 9-11 Years

Ingredients

225g butter softened, plus extra for greasing

450g Bramley or sharp apples

Finely grated zest and juice of 1 lemon

225g caster sugar, plus extra for dredging

3 large eggs

225g self-raising flour

2tsp baking powder

25g ground almonds

1 tbsp Demerara sugar

- 1. Preheat oven to 180 / fan160 / Gas 4. Grease a 23/24cm spring form cake tin and line with baking paper. Peel, core and cut the apples into 1cm pieces and toss in lemon juice.
- 2. Cream together the butter, caster sugar and lemon zest until pale and fluffy. Beat in the eggs, one at a time, adding a little flour with each addition to keep the mix smooth.
- 3. Sift the remaining flour and the baking powder into the bowl and fold in with the ground almonds. Drain the apple pieces well, then stir into the mix.
- 4. Spoon into the prepared tin, level the top and sprinkle with the Demerara sugar. Bake in the oven for one hour or until well-risen (cover with baking paper at about 45 minutes if it starts to brown too much). After removing from the tin, dredge with caster sugar.
